<p>How do we teach art?</p>	<p>The main characteristic of the art teaching in the Faculty of Fine Arts is the way the artistic work is conducted by the teacher in the framework of the subject program (example).</p> <p>Students do not have a permanent own space in the faculty (individual studio spaces), neither a workshop dedicated exclusively to the students' single work. However, they can use the workshops (metal and woodwork, painting, foundry, photo set, etc.), cameras for loaning out, with the authorization of the teacher.</p> <p>Subjects are organized in groups between 20 and 40 students per class. This entails a limitation of subjects' places for students (exchange and non-exchange). It also entails a well-structured subject program</p>
<p>Students enjoy</p>	<p>University Campus: As part of one of the most prestigious Technical Universities in Spain, students benefit of a huge range of facilities and services (such as Sports Area, Medical Service, Language Center, etc.)</p> <p>Subjects in other school/faculties: Exchange students can select up to 20% credits in subjects from other schools/faculties UPV (such as Architecture, Design Engineering, etc.). This can be an asset for students looking for diverse curricula.</p>

Application procedure	<p>1.-Get your UPV user and password at: www.opii.upv.es/incomings</p> <p>2.-After receiving your PIN and PASSWORD, complete and confirm the online application at the same website</p> <p>3.-<u>Upload</u> your application documents.</p> <p><i>Applicants will be receiving emails with instructions along the application process.</i></p>
Required application documents	<p>DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED before application deadline:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Printed application, stamped and signed by the home university and student. • Transcript of records (academic results) • Motivation letter/Letter of Intent • Spanish language skills certificate/OLS test (min.A1) • Portfolio -. PDF format. Max. 2MB (Except Conservation students) <p>Please don't send paper documents!</p>
Language Requirements	<p>Recommended: Spanish B1</p> <p>On application stage, students are required to attach a certificate/OLS test results at least A1 level.</p> <p>Upon arrival to Valencia, students are required to achieve an A2 level. Conservation students should achieve a B1 upon arrival.</p>



	<p>Please note that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1.-Tuition in Spanish2.-Spanish courses offered from A2 (no A1 courses offered) <p>Students will do a placement test at the beginning of the semester, in order to confirm their A2 level certificate. If they fail the exam, they will not be able to join the Spanish language lessons.</p>
Course selection	<p>Course selection made on application stage is merely for informative purposes. Places in subjects for Exchange students are assigned on a first-come first-served basis, taking into account their background.</p> <p>Students will be able to do a definitive registration in subjects two months before their arrival to UPV.</p> <p>Subjects in the area of design, animation, illustration or photography have few places for exchange students. Students are encouraged to think about alternative options in case of being rejected in one or more subjects.</p>
