

Guidelines for contributors

1. Only original and previously unpublished articles will be considered for publication. Authors should refrain from submitting any work that is being reviewed simultaneously or pending publication in other forums.
2. Contributions are welcome in any language and should not exceed 6,000 words in length, including annexes, tables and bibliographic references.
3. Articles must include two abstracts (no more than 150 words each), one being in the language used in the article itself and another in English. If the paper is written in English, only one abstract in English is required. A maximum of six key words should be provided in the same language(s) as the abstract(s).
4. Authors should send two printed copies (hard copies) of the manuscript in addition to an electronic version of the final paper (via electronic mail or floppy disk) to the address given below. Please include the full name(s) of contributing author(s) as well as the manuscript title when sending the electronic version. To maintain confidentiality, neither the name(s) of the author(s) nor the institution(s) of affiliation are to appear on the two aforementioned hard copies that are to be mailed to the postal address provided below.
5. A separate cover page, to be posted along with the two printed manuscripts, should include the manuscript title, name(s) of the author(s) and institutional affiliation, mailing address, e-mail address and telephone number of the person to whom correspondence should be directed.
6. Upon receipt of the submission, the corresponding author will be notified by e-mail. The Editorial Board will then forward the two anonymous papers to the Consultant Editors for evaluation.

7. The contributions accepted for publication are those that reflect scientific excellence (analytical rigor, sound methodology, significant findings, etc.) in any of the five research areas designated by the journal. Only those manuscripts prepared according to the instructions below will be considered for review and publication.
8. The Editorial Board will reject any contribution that fails to comply with the guidelines for contributors or the instructions for manuscript preparation.
9. As this journal is to be published once a year in the month of March, contributions must be received no later than November 30th of the preceding year.
