

**INVITATION TO A CARPE WORKSHOP ON APPLIED SUSTAINABLE
DEVELOPMENT AT THE HAMBURG UNIVERSITY OF APPLIED SCIENCES
FEBRUARY 7. – 8. 2013, HAMBURG, GERMANY**

CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS

Venue: HAW Hamburg, Berliner Tor 5, D-20099 Hamburg

Background

Matters related to Sustainable Development are already part of the mainstream European research agenda. Indeed, both in FP7 right now and at forthcoming HORIZON 2020 initiative in particular, an applied dimension to sustainable development (e.g. sustainable transport, sustainable water use, sustainable energy use, etc) will be needed, so as to ensure its technological and societal relevance. Consistent with this trend and bearing in mind the many advantages a practice-based approach to sustainable development may bring about, the “Workshop on Applied Sustainable Development” is being proposed.

Aims

The workshop will:

- a) Present and discuss approaches, methods and experiences in implementing sustainability-related projects at CARPE member universities and beyond.
- b) Introduce and discuss a possible participation at forthcoming European and international Calls, where members of the CARPE network interested in the subject area of sustainable development may come together, to share ideas and identify concrete themes for projects.
- c) Evaluate the chance for a FP7-proposal in 2013 is possible

Target groups

The workshop is targeted to members of the CARPE consortium Universities: lecturers and RDI personnel interested in projects about and around the issue of sustainable development.

Structure

The event will be divided into two main sections. Section 1 will consist of presentations of current works, projects and experiences at CARPE member universities. Section 2 will consist of the presentation of project ideas and of forthcoming and appropriate Calls, where the participants may express an interest to contribute towards. The idea is that participants may subsequently organize themselves in a way that they can pursue these Calls, following-up the workshop.

Expected Outputs

The workshop is expected to lead to a better understanding of the know-how and potentials of the CARPE Consortium on sustainable development and to the identification of concrete funding possibilities to be pursued by those attending the meeting.

Conditions for participation

In order to maximize the use of the time, interested participants should send a 200 words summary of their inputs (presentation or project idea), to the Hamburg team, who will then structure and organize the inputs in an appropriate way. The details, consistent with other CARPE workshops, are:

- 200 words abstract in English
- Format: A4 document (pdf, MS Word), font size 12
- Deadline for submission of the abstract: 15.1.2013?

- The organizing team will select the presentations suitable for the workshop and structure them.

Participants are expected to contribute via either a presentation, by bringing a project idea for discussion, or by strong interest to contribute to a joint project.
