Spelling and grammar should conform to standard British-English usage. Authors are requested to have the abstracts properly revised if necessary. **Indicate your preferred form of presentation (oral/poster).** **Abstracts must be sent to the Secretarial Office** and only electronic submissions will be accepted (congresos.valencia@viajeseci.es).

A field trip to the Utiel-Requena wine-producing area will be undertaken on June the 20th and will include visits to a vineyard and a winery. Please, remember that the **Registration Fee** does not include the field trip and Workshop dinner registration.
