AND CONFERENCE REGISTRATION FORM

The EUROCALL 97 conference on the theme WHERE RESEARCH AND PRACTICE MEET, will be held at Dublin City University, Dublin from 11-13 September 1997. Participants are invited to submit proposals for section papers, show & tell and poster sessions of 25 minutes on the following topics:

- . integrating CALL into the curriculum
- . innovation in classroom applications
- . software tools and resources
- . new development in multimedia
- . telematics, self-access and distance learning
- . CALL in theory and practice

Show and Tell sessions

Participants having developed an original piece of software are invited to give a 5 minute talk followed by 30 minute demonstration.

Poster sessions

Participants are invited to present developmental work in progress in the format of a poster. Selected posters will be on display for the duration of the conference and attendance times will be allocated for informal discussions. Please be prepared to bring with you any computer hardware and software you require as only electrical power points will be supplied on your stand.

Guidelines for submissions of proposals

Proposals will be examined and selected by the Eurocall academic panel. Please indicate clearly the appropriate session for your proposal. Please send the abstracts to the conference secretariat in the format indicated below. ***The deadline for the submission of abstracts is 31 January 1997.*** Participants will be informed of the panel's decision by 31 March 1997. The format of the proposal should be as follows:

Session (parallel paper session, show & tell session or poster session)

Title

Proposal/Abstract

Parallel Paper Session

Abstracts should be approx. 600 words long and submitted on diskette (saved as Word for Windows or ASCII) with 1.5 lines spacing, Times New Roman 11 pt font. Please enclose three hard copies. In addition, a 300 words summary and biographical data (3 lines maximum) should be included for publication in the book of abstracts.

Show and Tell and Posters Sessions

Proposals should be 300 words long with a clear description of the software e.g. type, technical specifications, desired learning outcomes, design principles, stage of development (pilot or Beta-testing, implementation, evaluation, etc.) and main characteristics.

Conference proceeding

Selected papers from the conference will be published as a special double issue of CALL in May 1998. Presenters who would like to submit their paper for the proceedings will be given guidelines and style sheets. The manuscript should be handed in to the conference office or the text sent to the conference secretariat no later than 31 October 1997. All papers submitted will be refereed by the editorial board and presenters will be informed of the result by 31 December 1997.

Please book early to avoid disappointments. There is a maximum of 300 places. The registration fee includes: conference fee, conference package, registration buffet (Wednesday evening), welcome party (Thursday evening), lunches, coffee and refreshments, conference dinner and Irish evening, proceedings.
