Professor for Telecommunications

The new professor will hold the appointment for teaching and research in the areas of network management, network planning and simulation of telecommunication networks. Your tasks will also include guiding students' projects in technology focused courses of study.

We are looking for a candidate who has an excellent scientific background and practical experience in at least two of the following fields:

- **Analysis, planning, simulation and operation of telecommunication networks,**
- **Network management,**
- **Theory of communication traffic.**

We expect the candidate to cooperate in the neighboring subject areas and to be prepared to instruct in both German and English.

Prerequisites for the application are a doctorate in engineering sciences, mathematics, physics, or in a related field, very good academic achievements, practical experience as well as teaching experience. Therefore, the teaching methodology should focus on areas related to the international information and telecommunications sector. Your expertise should be conveyed in the context of modern didactic scenarios and further developed in an interdisciplinary dialogue. We also expect you to have an open mind concerning modern forms of communication in direct and net-based study programs, extensive experience in international collaboration, good foreign language skills, as well as being prepared to participate in the academic self-government of the university.

The position will be completed in accordance with the University Act of the Free State of Saxony (December 10, 2008), which regulates these requirements under § 58. The position will be awarded as a Professor at the Hochschule für Telekommunikation in Leipzig, with employment beginning as soon as possible. Payment will be based on the collective agreements of Deutsche Telekom. The University is trying to increase its share of female employees and is, therefore, particularly interested in applications from female candidates. Disabled applicants will be given priority should the situation arise where there are candidates in the same category.
