

APPENDIX 3 - DESCRIPTION OF THE GRADING SYSTEM APPLIED AT EACH UNIVERSITY AND THEIR EQUIVALENCE

The qualifications obtained at CUAS are based on the German grading system and will be converted to the Spanish grading system used at UPV by the following equivalence table:
