	Upon arrival to Valencia, students are required to achieve an B1 level. Conservation students should achieve a B1 upon arrival. Please note that: 1Tuition in Spanish 2Spanish courses offered from A2 (no A1 courses offered) Students will do a placement test at the beginning of the semester, in order to confirm their B1 level certificate. If they fail the exam, they will not be able to join the Spanish language lessons.
Course selection	Course selection made on application stage is merely for informative purposes. Places in subjects for Exchange students are assigned on a first-come first-served basis, taking into account their background. Students will be able to do a definitive registration in subjects two months before their arrival to UPV. Registration period to be confirmed. Subjects in the area of design, animation, illustration or photography have few places for exchange students.
