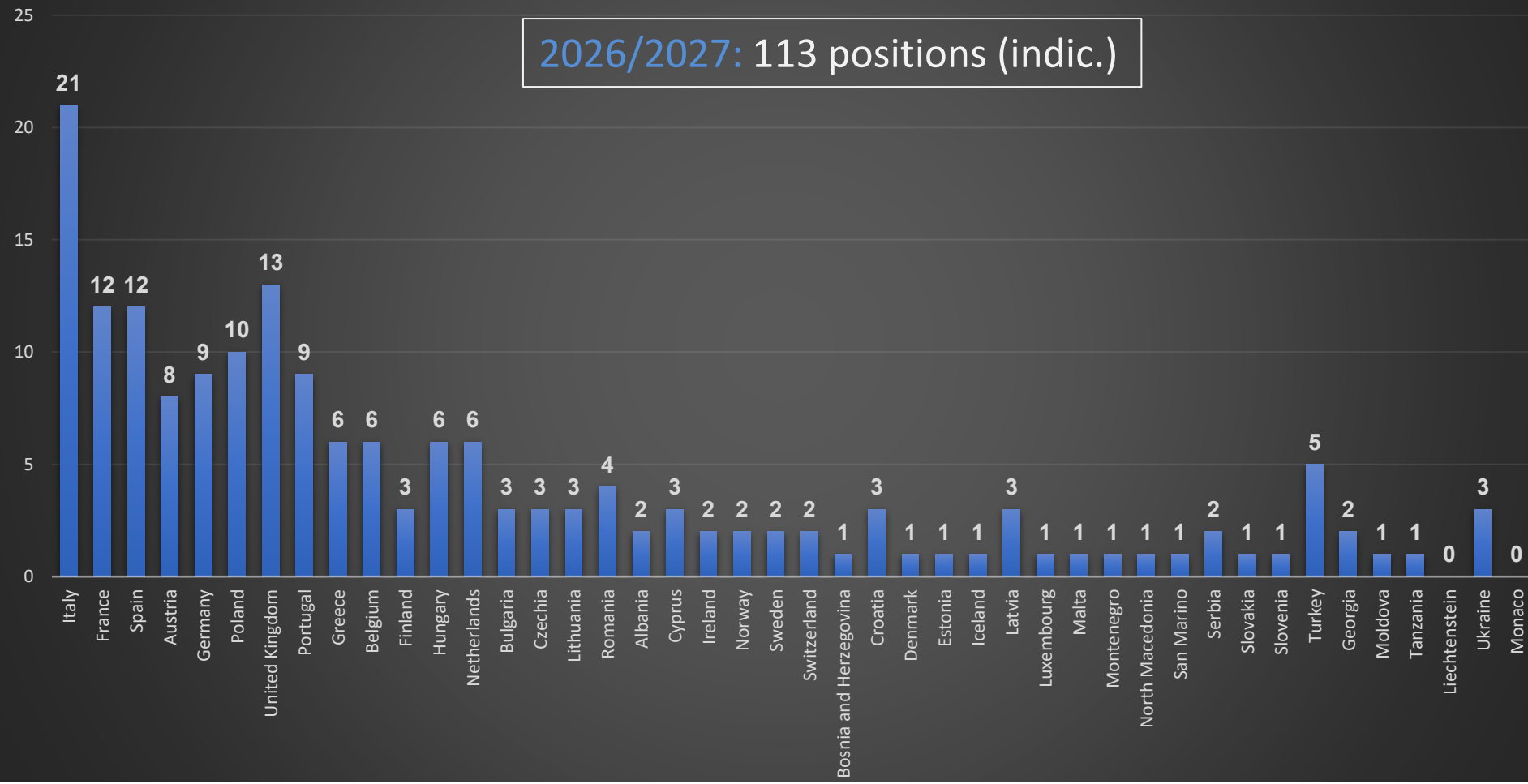

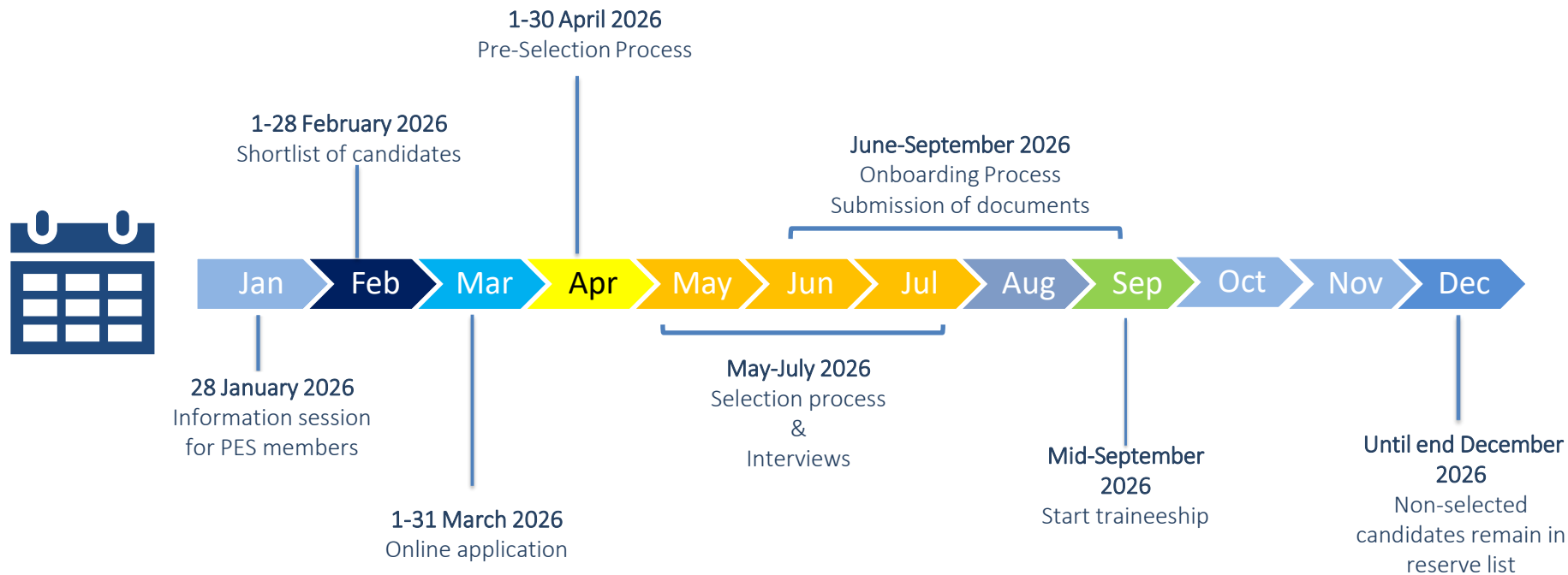

<b>01 February 2026</b>	Launch of the PES Traineeship Programme with the Universities
<b>up to 27 February 2026</b>	PES Member sends the EUIPO candidates shortlist to <b>Pan_European_Seal@euiipo.europa.eu</b>
<b>01 – 31 March 2026</b>	Shortlisted candidates (only) submit their online applications through the <a href="#">EUIPO e-recruitment tool</a>
<b>01 – 30 April</b>	Pre-selection process at EUIPO
<b>From May until July 2026</b>	Candidates are interviewed and selected by the EUIPO
<b>16 September 2026</b>	Start of the traineeship Programme at EUIPO
<b>Until 31 December 2026</b>	Non-selected candidates remain in Reserve List
