



Resolution of 07th of February 2020, from the Rector of the Universitat Politècnica de València, by which they convene POLINIZA DOS 2020 (URBAN ART MEETING)

FIRST. OBJECTIVE

The Cultural Activities Department of the Vice-Rectorate of Students, Culture and Sport of the Universitat Politècnica de València organizes, within the schedule of activities for POLINIZA DOS 2020 (The Urban Art Meeting), an event featuring artistic interventions on campus, which is related in terms of plastic materials as well as symbolically to its urban environment, either by making murals on an architectural surface, or with ephemeral interventions in space.

SECOND. PARTICIPANTS

This contest invites the participation open to all artists over 18 years old interested in taking part individually or collectively.

Those selected by the jury must present a project with the aim of creating a pictorial wall mural to be displayed on the walls dedicated to that purpose or an ephemeral exhibit at the Vera Campus Site of the UPV from 11th to 15th May 2020 inclusive, every day from 10 am to 6 pm on the walls authorised for this on the Vera Campus Site of the UPV.

THIRD. AWARDS

The grant total is 4.200 euros with sufficient and adequate funds existing in the budget, which are charged to the consignment 009010000-422-47110.

There will be 7 awards given out that include:

- The gross prize for each artist or group will be 600 euros (they will be paid by bank transfer) for every piece of wall art completed. There will be a maximum of 7 individual or collective pieces.
- The organization covers the travel, board and lodging expenses of the selected artists. Furthermore, the materials needed for the project will be provided to the participants.
- Prizes are subject to the appropriate tax deductions.

FOURTH. APPLICATIONS AND PRESENTATION OF THE PROJECTS

Anyone who wishes to participate in this contest must present a completed registration form available at the address www.upv.es/poliniza and they can include in it any link to their digital portfolio or website with the work presented.



Once all requests have been received, they will be processed at the General Registry Office of the Universitat Politècnica de València, located on the bottom floor of building 3F of the Vera Campus Site (Camino de Vera, s/n. 46022, Valencia), indicating the day on which they were

received through the form available at www.upv.es/poliniza, which will be considered as the date of submission for all purposes.

The application period begins the day after the summary of this resolution is published in the Official Gazette of the Generalitat Valenciana and ends on 26th, March 2020. If the application doesn't meet the requirements established in the contest's rules, the competent authority will require the applicant to make corrections to it within a maximum of 10 days, which may not be extended, and if not corrected, the application will be withdrawn.

The submission of an application constitutes the acceptance of the rules, as well as the specific legal obligations involved in receiving financial aid and grants.

FIFTH. ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY AND SELECTION COMMITTEE

The competent authority responsible for the contest process is the Vice-Rector for Students, Culture and Sport, any proceedings that occur will be published on the website (www.upv.es/entidades/ACU/index-es.html) and (www.upv.es/entidades/ACU/index-es.html)

A Selection Committee will be designated for the evaluation and selection of winners. In every case, the Committee will then communicate their choice to the Rector, for the final decision.

The Selection Committee may declare any of the awards vacant, if the candidates' projects do not meet the quality expected, or other justifiable reasons, which will then be left up to the Rector to make the final decision.

The Committee will resolve any issues that may arise during the contest objectively and transparently.

The contest's Administrative Authority and Selection Committee agree to not disclose, transmit or reveal to third parties any information for their own benefit or for third parties, regarding the projects submitted.

The names of all the candidates that apply and meet the requirements will be published on the website (www.upv.es/entidades/ACU/index-es.html) and (www.upv.es/entidades/ACU/index-es.html) and all the applicants will also be notified via email as well.

The evaluations and selection of winners will be done by a Selection Committee consisting of: the Vice-Rector for Students, Culture and Sport, the Director of the Office



of Cultural Activities, the Vice-Dean of Culture in the Faculty of Fine Arts, a professor of the School of Building Engineering, the commissioner of POLINIZA DOS, the coordinator of POLINIZA DOS and a representative of the students.

The Committee will select and propose the winners, once all applications have been reviewed and the evaluation criteria are applied, with the presented documents.

After assessing the information provided, the panel of judges will select the participants for the event. At the same time, they must present a sketch of the project within 15 calendar days from the communication of the resolution and they will commit to creating it in accordance with the terms contained in these rules.

SIXTH. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The prizes will be awarded on a competition-type basis.

The selection will take place respecting the principles of publicity, transparency, competitiveness, objectiveness, equality, consistency and non-discrimination.

The evaluation criteria will be:

1. Career and/or academic and art education
2. Participation in exhibitions, events, festivals and other urban art shows
3. Continuing work in performing artistic interventions in public spaces

SEVENTH. SELECTION AND RESOLUTION PROCEDURES

The Committee will provide their resolution proposal, with the list of the winners, to the Rector, who will determine the outcome of the contest.

For notification purposes, the final results will be published on (www.upv.es/entidades/ACU/index-es.html) and (www.upv.es/poliniza/) no later than the 30th april 2020. Additionally, the beneficiaries will receive communication at the email address that the Universitat has provided.

All the resolutions adopted will be considered substantiated.

EIGHTH. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

The artists will transfer the rights of their works to the UPV, who may make free use of them and determine their time of stay in the exhibition space, which in some cases may be longer than the time elapsed between consecutive editions. For his part, the Vice-Rectorate of Students, Culture and Sport is committed to disseminating the prize through the usual channels and will provide the infrastructure and materials needed for the implementation of the selected project. At the same time, the author or group



of authors are committed to completing the project presented within the established timeline.

NINTH. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

In accordance with the provisions set forth in the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 and the Organic Law 3/2018, of December 5, on Personal Data Protection and the guarantee of digital rights, we hereby inform you that the data controller for the data processed as part of this call is the Univeristat Politècnica de València. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is the need to manage the award granting procedure of this call. No disposals or international transfers of your personal data processed are foreseen. Data subjects may exercise the rights of access, rectification, suppression, portability, limitation or objection to the processing by providing a copy of an official document that identifies them, and if applicable, the accrediting documentation of their request to the Data Protection Officer of the Universitat Politècnica de València, General Secretary. Universitat Politècnica de València, Camí de Vera, s/n 46022-València. In the event of a claim, the competent authority is the Spanish Data Protection Agency. The data shall be stored by virtue of the legislation applicable to this processing.

TENTH. APPEALS

Against this contest and its rules, as well as its resolution, which completes the administrative process, an optional appeal may be filed with the UPV Rectorate within one month, calculated from the day following publication, in accordance with the provisions of articles 123 and 124 of Law 39/2015, of October 1, on the Common Administrative Procedures for Public Administration, of January 13 or a contentious-administrative appeal within the contentious-administrative jurisdiction of the Comunidad Valenciana, within two months from the day following the notification of this resolution, in accordance with articles 14 and 46 of Law 29/1998, of July 13, regulating the Contentious-Administrative Jurisdiction.
