


ACCESSIBILITY GUIDE FOR PEOPLE WITH MOTOR WEAKNESS IN ENVIRONMENT WINDOWS XP

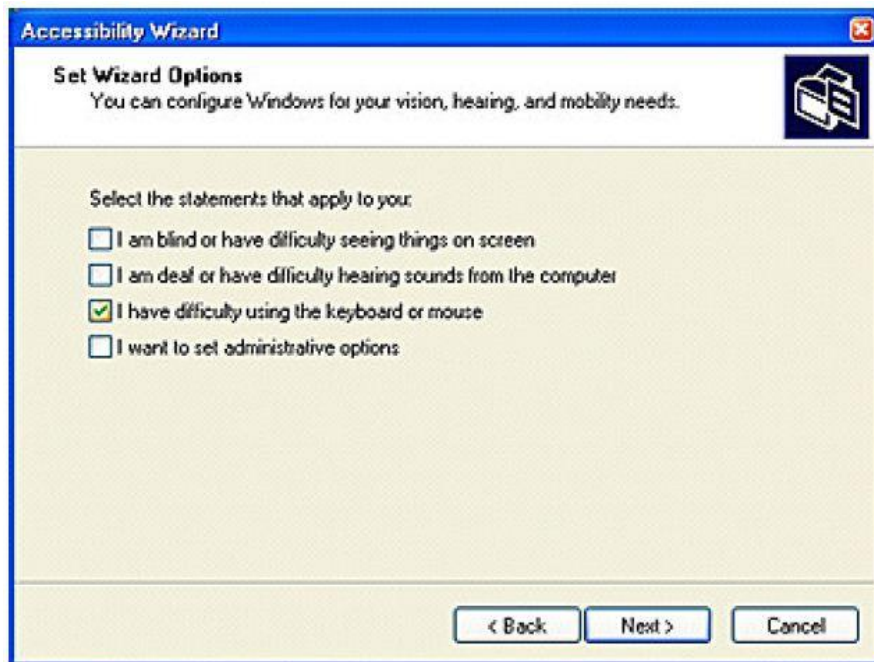
1. How to configure the options if you have difficulty using the keyboard or mouse.

If you have difficulty using the keyboard or mouse, you can configure quickly the options with the **Accessibility Wizard**. The major problems motor options are StickyKeys, MouseKeys y FilterKeys, the more help you get to use the programs, and you can select the size and color of the cursor and blink rate and the configuration of mouse buttons.

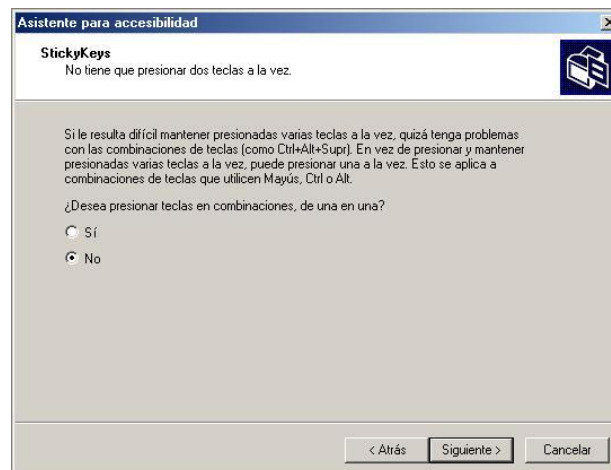
	Using the mouse	Using the keyboard
1	In the Start menu : <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Select Programs.• Click on Accessories.• Select Accessibility.• Click on Accessibility wizard.	Click the start menú pressing CTRL+ESC (or the Windows logo key ). <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Press E.• Write accwiz• Press INTRO.•
2	Select the welcome dialog box to the Accessibility Wizard : <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Select Next.	Once in the welcome dialog box to the Accessibility wizard : <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Press T
3	In the dialog box Tex Size : <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Select the smallest text you can read.• Press Next.	In the dialog box Tex Size : <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Select the smallest text you can read by pressing the UP ARROW and DOWN ARROW.• Press T.

	Using the mouse	Using the keyboard
4	<p>In the dialog box Screen configuration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make sure the box Screen configuration is selected. Change font size. • If it is not. <u>S</u>elect it. • To use Microsoft Magnifier, select the box to Use Microsoft Magnifier. • Click Next. 	<p>In the dialog box Screen configuration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make sure the box Screen configuration is selected • If it is not. <u>S</u>elect it pressing C. • To use Microsoft Magnifier press U. • Press T.
5	<p>In the dialog box Configure accessibility wizard :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select the box I have difficulty using the keyboard or mouse. • Press Next for continue using the wizard. 	<p>In the dialog box Configure accessibility wizard:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select the box I have difficulty using the keyboard or mouse press M. • Press T for continue using the wizard. <p>(Use the arrow keys and press ENTER to go by selecting the appropriate options).</p>
6	<p>In the Ending dialog box the Accessibility Wizard:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click Finish to save and exit wizard. <p>Note: To cancel the changes, select Cancel and then Not</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To move back to screens above, press the Back button. 	<p>In the Ending dialog box the Accessibility Wizard:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Press INTRO to save and exit wizard. <p>Note: To cancel the changes use the tabulator to go to the Cancel button and then press INTRO. Tab to select No and then press ENTER.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To move back to screens above, press the Back button press A.
