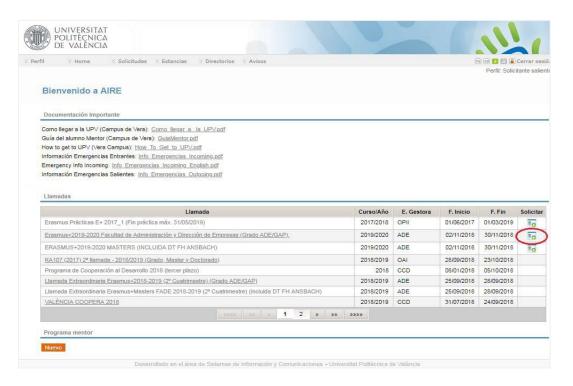


INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE ERASMUS APPLICATION 2026-2027

Access to the application is through the UPV personal intranet, in the "International Relations and Cooperation" section at the end of the intranet menu, or directly through https://aplicat.upv.es/aire-app



Once you're in the AIRE home, you can view all available calls for applications at any time. To submit an application, you have to use the icon next to the call that you are interested in and that corresponds to your academic unit.

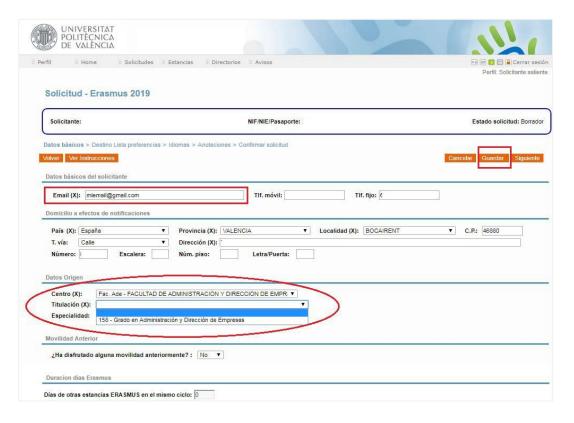




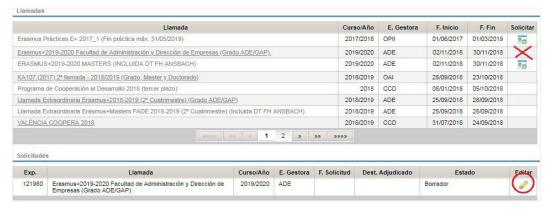
Tab [Basic Data]

To save the application for the first time, you must enter your School or Faculty at UPV (Master's degree Unit). Do not forget to use the Save button every time you write or edit new data on any of the tabs in your application. Make sure you see a wark on top of the screen (it means the new data was saved correctly).

You must also include a valid email address. It can be either the UPV email or a private email account, but ensure that the email address you use is correct and the one you check most frequently. Both AIRE (automatic messages during the process) and the UPV International Relations staff will contact you through this email.



Next time you want to access your application, it will appear on the AIRE home webpage, below the list of application calls available (see the image below). You can also find it through the upper menu "Applications".







It will be possible for you to create several applications for the same call, but you cannot do so while you have an application in the status "Draft". In that case, the button for creating a new application will disappear from the AIRE homepage. As soon as you complete and register one application, you will be able to create another one, and the button will reappear on the homepage next to the name of the call for applications.

Tab [Destinations]

In this tab, you have to indicate the host destination(s) you are interested in, the type of Activity, and the period of mobility at the host institution you are applying to: Semester A = Winter semester; Semester B = Spring semester, or Full Academic Year. For the purpose of this call, you can only select "Full academic year".

If you indicate several universities, the order in which you include them on your application will be binding. We will allocate the host university after consulting with the Head (Academic Coordinator) of the MSc Plant Health, who is in touch with the other institutions of the Plant Health Consortium.

Tab [Languages]

• On the upper part of this screen, students can write the foreign languages they know (self-assessment) and also request to take a level test of German and French. THERE WILL BE NO ENGLISH TEST. Only French and German level tests will be conducted (on 12-13 December).

The French and German tests are optional, and taking them will not affect your choices in any way during this call. You only need to check the box to indicate that you are interested in taking the French or German test if you have some knowledge of either of these languages, but no official certificate, and you want to take the test to demonstrate your skills and earn extra points in the ranking formula.



Do not include your language certificates in this section. Merge them into one single PDF file and upload it later on in the tab [Confirm application].



• The lower section of the tab [Languages] allows students to include any courses (subjects) they may have completed previously <u>at UPV</u> in a previous academic year. This only applies to you if you have completed a bachelor's degree at UPV before entering the Plant Health master's degree.



Tab [Remarks / Annotations]

You do not need to take any action here. It is possible that the UPV International Relations staff will eventually write an internal remark about your file here, but this section is most likely to remain empty. To complete your application, please proceed to the final tab.

Tab [Confirm application]

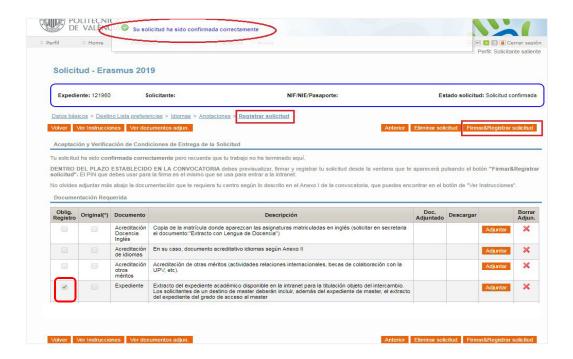
The next step is the Confirm Application button. Check that you have included all the information in the previous tabs and confirm the application. AIRE will ask you, if you have not done so, to check the box at the bottom, in which you declare that you are aware of what you have to make the application valid.

If you already have the documents you want to attach, you can attach them on this screen, before or after confirming the request. You will be able to modify the documents until the moment you decide to sign and register the application.





Once you have used the button Confirm application (not before), a new button will appear: Sign and Register Application and the screen will look like this:



In order to Sign&Register application you must upload any documents that may appear obligatory for the application (marked with a \checkmark). If you wish to submit any optional documents, please do so now, before registering the application and closing it.

English language certificates (English obligatory, other languages optional) must be merged into one single PDF file and uploaded here, not in the tab [Languages].







Preview the application before signing it (it is obligatory). Finally, sign it by clicking the Sign and Register application button in the pop-up window (image below).



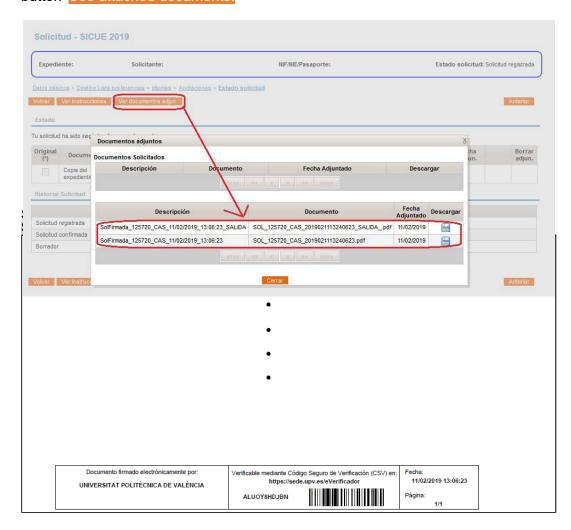
The registration process may take several seconds. Do not close the browser until the process finishes. If everything goes well, you will see the screen as shown below, and you will receive an email informing you that the REGISTRATION has been completed successfully.

The number that appears in the message corresponds to the registration number in GEISER, the official Digital Registry of the UPV. Be cautious of potential errors in the registry. The postal code must be for an address in Spain, with 5 digits, for example. If you encounter an error, please send a screenshot along with the message to mobility@upv.es.
