## ERASMUS DEADLINES AND PROCEDURE

### Deadlines for nomination By Home University:

Fall/Winter Semester or Annual: **15<sup>th</sup> of June**

Spring/Summer Semester: **15<sup>th</sup> of October**

### Deadlines for application By nominated students:

Fall/Winter Semester or Annual: **15<sup>th</sup> of July**

Spring/Summer Semester: : **15<sup>th</sup> of November**

After receiving the nomination email with the students' information, they will receive a communication from us to:

1. register on the University of Pisa's [ALICE portal](#);
2. sign up on the [Erasmus Mobility portal](#) and upload their **Learning Agreement in PDF\*** (or submit it via OLA).

3. After the Application form have been approved, you will need **to make an appointment with the UNIPI central office** for September /October so you can pick up your **student card**. [Here all information](#).

Detailed instructions for registration and access to the Erasmus portal will be sent only by email directly to the students.

***\*The Learning Agreement must be signed by the student and the coordinator of the home university. The Italian courses must include the code and credits.***

The deadlines are not mandatory, but it is recommended to meet them because we need to approve the Learning Agreements before the summer

Some courses can be divided into A-B or A-B-C because they are attended by many students. The reference is the first surname.

### **Course divided into A-B:**

course A) – first surname from A to L

course B) – first surname from M to Z

### **Course divided into A-B-C:**

course A) – first surname from A to D

course B) – first surname from E to N

course C) – first surname from O to Z

Transcript of Records – AFTER the Mobility	<p>As soon as the student has finished his/her exams, he/she has to download the ECTS <b>Transcript from the ALICE Portal</b> and send it, along with the <b>Certificate of Attendance</b>, to <a href="mailto:rapp.int@jus.unipi.it">rapp.int@jus.unipi.it</a> to have them signed by our Erasmus Coordinator. Then they can come to the International Office at the department to pick up the signed copies of their ECTS Transcript and Certificate of Attendance. A PDF copy will also be emailed to their home university.</p>						

## LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION and LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE

Most of our courses are taught in Italian.

**An Italian language certificate is not mandatory, but a B1 in ITALIAN level is highly recommended.**

Some courses are taught in English.

For the English-taught courses that are part of the Master's degree, a **B1 level English certificate is required.**

**The University of Pisa offers a free Italian language course to all Incoming Erasmus students.**

1. Students must access the web page of [University Language Center \(CLI\)](#) with their ALICE credentials and register for the placement test.
2. The test result will place each student in a course appropriate to their level of competence.
3. Courses generally start in October and end in February (for the first semester) and start in March and end in June (for the second semester).
